The Cornell system for taking notes is designed to save time: you do not have to rewrite notes with this system. It suits people who prefer a linear way of note-taking. Step 1: preparation Use an A4 looseleaf file or ring binder. Use only one side of the paper: you can later lay your notes out to see the direction of a lecture.

All notes from the class go into the main note-taking column. The smaller column on the left side is for comments, questions or hints about the actual notes. After the lecture, you should take a moment to summarise the main ideas of the page in the section at the bottom which will speed up your reviewing and studying process immensely.

The idea behind this is very easy. All actual notes from the lecture go into the main note-taking column. The smaller column on the left side is for questions about the notes that can be answered when reviewing and keywords or comments that make the whole reviewing and exam preparation process easier.
